

Historical Lineage of Barbara Harmon-Donaldson Bryant

2019 Update

Barbara Harmon was born in Franksville, Alabama to Eli Harmon and Luvenia Boyd-Harmon in 1897. Barbara had two sisters and one brother whose names are listed as: Annie Harmon, James "Jim" Harmon and Sophronia Harmon-Harris. New information was gained from about her family through Ancestry.com DNA testing of Elnora Donaldson.

Annie Harmon was born in 1885 and died in 1910 she was the mother of one son with John Shinn Sr. born 1885- died 1971. Their son's name was Eli Shinn Sr. born in 1905 and died in 1971. Eli Shinn Sr. (nephew of Barbara Harmon) was the father of seven sons and two daughters with his wife whose name was Lula Mae Merida. Not much is known about all of Eli Shinn Sr.'s children but according to DNA information Eli Shinn Sr. had a son named Eli Shinn Jr. and, Johnny Lee Shinn, James "Coup" Shinn and a daughter Mary Ann Shinn. No information is available about the other five children. Barbara had another sister named Sophronia Harmon –Harris she had a daughter whose name was Clara, it is said that Clara moved away to California with her husband and they had six children. Her brother James Harmon was born in 1893 and was the father of one son.

Grandmother Luvenia Boyd-Harmon had a sister whose name was Virginia Wilson whose nickname was "Jennie "she was born in 1860 and was believed to have died in 1962 which would have made her 102 years old. There was also a second sister whose name was "Vic "who was actually a twin. The parents of Grandmother Luvenia Boyd-Harmon were named Calvin and Annette Boyd and together they had 10 daughters whose names were as follows: these are the sisters of Grandmother Luvenia Harmon. Susan Boyd- 1864-1885, Jenny Boyd (Virginia) Sallie Boyd- 1862, Alice Boyd born 1868, Jane Boyd-and Victoria Boyd 1870 (twins), Fannie Boyd born 1875, Polly Boyd born 1879 and Pauline Boyd born 1881-1922.

After the death of **Eli Harmon grandmother Luvenia** married again to a member of the **Bumpers** family his name is not known at this time. All of the names listed in this document are linked to us by DNA according to other family trees listed in the Ancestry.com database. We will continue to add new information to "**Mama Barbara's** lineage as new information becomes available.

Donaldson Family Lineage – 2019 Update

William "Willie" Donaldson – 1810-1872 born in North Carolina

Willie Donaldson's name is listed as William Donaldson on his last will and testament. His will also listed six names as siblings and one that we are not sure of. The list below is his sisters and brothers: Donald, Henry, Susan, James, Samuel, Helen Vomers, and Malvina Winston and a Francis Husst who we are not sure if she (Francis) is a sibling.

According his will, William "Willie" Donaldson fathered four children whose names are listed as: Henry Jr., James, Susan and Samuel Donaldson.

According to information that we found on Ancestry.com Willie's wife was named Margaret. We have no further information on her at this time.

* Although he is listed as a child of Willie Donaldson on his will, we do not know who the children of Samuel Donaldson are nor do we have any information on him at this time.

Henry Donaldson Jr. (son of Willie) 1854 - 1952 was married twice, first to Rhoda Jordan. Henry Jr. and Rhoda Jordan had nine children together. His second wife was said to be named Susie Brown. We have no idea how many of the 20 children were from his second wife. Henry Jr. fathered 20 children whose names were Will, Mary, Minnie, Surry, Abel, James, Carlean, Selma, Mattie, Eva, Ernest, Joe, Margie, Leila, Emma, Willie, Janie, Alberts, Easter, and McHenry. There are census records that show some of their names and dates of birth.

SUSAN DONALDSON- BUMPERS (daughter of Willie Donaldson)1860-1936 had eleven children, Elmira, Alomie, Maggie, Sarah, Daisy, Georgia, Harry, James, Dave, Fronier, and Amos. Her husband was named George Bumpers he was born in 1855 and died in 1922. Census data shows some of the names and dates of birth and marriages of their children.

JAMES DONALDSON(son of Willie Donaldson) 1862-1912 is the sibling that our lineage comes from. James was married to LENNIS COLEMAN and to MAGGIE ELLIOTT. He fathered fifteen children, Pleasant, Sidney, Henry, Sam, Donald, Abraham, Don, Elijah, William, Johnnie, Ida, Lina, Sophie, Evie, and Margaret. Lennis Coleman married James Donaldson on August 31, 1882. There is census data and records that give detailed information on the children of James Donaldson.

SAM DONALDSON(son of James Donaldson)

SAM DONALDSON was born on May 10, 1892, the son of Lennis and James. He had three sons and seven daughters with **BARBARA HARMON**. They were married on September 3, 1918. They enjoyed 41 years of marriage until he died in November 1959 at the age of 67 years old. Sam and Barbara are both buried at Mount Bethel Cemetery in Franksville, Alabama.



Donaldson Family Confession of Faith and Declaration

- 7. We decree and declare completion of "destiny assignments" to the glory of God and the release of spirituals gifting, callings, and ministries for the fulfillment of kingdom work.
- 8. We decree and declare the grace and favor of God upon every family member such that the blessings of God in Deuteronomy 28 follow us and overtake us continually.
- 9. We decree that we are the head only and not the tail, we are above only and never beneath.

- 10. We decree and declare that we shall lend and not borrow, that wealth and riches shall be in our homes and that we shall reside in goodly houses with godly peace and contentment.
- 11. We decree that we are blessed in the city, blessed in the field, blessed when we come and when we go.
- 12. We decree and declare that the work of our hands is blessed that our baskets and storehouses are blessed.
- 13. We decree and declare that when we are obedient we shall reign as kings and queens in the earth as joint heirs with Jesus Christ.
- 14. We decree and declare that every satanic assignment, iniquity, generational curse, and spirit of infirmity is cancelled, henceforth, now and forevermore.
- 15. We decree and declare that this family shall bring forth much fruit and our fruit shall remain as we allow ourselves to become planted in the house of the Lord and flourish in the courts of our God.
- 16. We call these things that are not; as though they were and we receive them all by unwavering faith... In the name of Jesus Christ our Lord...Amen...It Is So!
